

Program of the Workshop

The program contained five parts:

- First part contained lectures presented by famous doctors neurologists, pulmologists, psychiatrists: concerning importance of application of NIPPV in ALS/MND patients and also when and how to use, as well as how to solve many problems to adapt to NIPPV.
- 2 The second part was education and training of nurses from Serbia how to use NIPPV, cough machine, nasal pressure meter SNIP by special monitors a doctor specialist and a nurse specialized in treating patients on ventilatory support.
- 3 The third part consisted of lectures presented by medical health professionals how to educate/train nurses to recognize what are the first signs of respiratory insufficiency in ALS/MND patients, how to use NIPPV machines in home environment and which are the most frequent problems for the patients and members of their families when using NIPPV machines in home environment.
- 4 The fourth part of the workshop was about education and training of patients and members of their families in home settings how to use NIPPV by special monitors a doctor specialist and a nurse specialized in treating patients on ventilatory support.
- **5** Finally, the aim of the fifth part was to inform us about the quality of the workshop: the participants filled in the evaluation papers.
- We gave the CD with all lectures to all participants.

New Brochure

- All participants also received a new brochure "Dišite sa lakoćom" (Breathe without a problem) the guidelines for all ALS/MND patients and all other patients with neuromuscular disorders who have a problems with breathing and need NIPPV support
- The brochure was printed in 1000 copies, by the Serbian Muscle Dystrophy Association, with donation of Representatives of the companies which produce NIPPV "Breas"/TREVIS



Participants

- The participants were the health professionals from the main Clinical Centers in Serbia and patients with ALS as well as members of their families.
- The total number of participants was 83 (59 medical health professionals and 24 ALS patients and members of their families).

Budget Item

Total Budget for one day Worshop was 1,120 € (1,800 \$ CAD), which includes:

- Organization and administration costs
- Food
- Renting the Meeting room
- 3 new Masks for NIPPV and 1 new Respiratory Pressure Meter (Micro RPM®)
- All lecturers as well as coordinator will provide their services on voluntary bases!
- Representatives of the companies which produce NIPPV
 —"Breas" will provide 2 NIPPV for the use during the
 workshop and donation of 200 € for the workshop

Conclusion

- The workshop was very successful and all participants were very satisfied with the knowledge which they obtained.
- Firstly we tried to improve and optimize the health system as a whole, thanks to the successful training and education of health professionals from different settings in the various medical centers in Serbia.
- Secondly, due to practical education all health professionals who were attended to the workshop we were qualified for the practical work with patients or members of their families who need NIPPV and also transfer their knowledge to other medical staff in their medical centers in Serbia.
- **3 Thirdly**, at the same time ALS/MND patients and the members of their families who were attend the workshop were fully informed about the use of the NIPPV.
- It is extremely important to organize such workshop at least once per year for better knowledge and training of the medical staff and patients about NIPPV, with idea to improve the quality of medical health care and also decrease the expenses of the patients treatment in hospital settings.
